



Sew Modern Christmas Stockings

Who says Christmas stockings have to be red and green? In this class, Liana shows you how to give traditional Christmas stockings a modern makeover with fresh, vibrant fabrics. These stockings require minimal cutting and sewing, making it easy to whip up a batch for your family. The neutral linen lining and leather strap tie the palette together, making your large-scale florals and colorful prints look cohesive when they're all hanging together over the fireplace.



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You will Learn:

- How to cut out pattern pieces
- How to clip curves
- How to insert and attach the stocking lining
- How to add a strap

Tools & Materials:

- 1 yard print fabric
- 1 yard neutral linen fabric
- Thread to match linen
- 8" of 1/2"-wide ribbon, cotton twill, or leather
- Leather needle (only if sewing leather strap)
- Seam ripper
- Chalk
- Pins
- Fabric shears
- Snips
- Sewing machine
- Iron and ironing board

Stocking Template

Stocking Lining

For lining template, cut out full pattern piece.
Cut two from lining fabric.

Exterior Stocking

For exterior stocking template, fold pattern piece at dotted line.

Cut two from fabric with right sides together.
