

*Materials:*

- Light worsted weight yarn in Green (like Cascade 220)
- G hook (or what ever size is appropriate for your yarn weight)
- Scissors

*Abbreviations:*

<b>ch(s):</b>	chain(s)
<b>dc:</b>	double crochet
<b>sc:</b>	single crochet
<b>sk:</b>	skip
<b>sl st:</b>	slip stitch

**CROCHETED LEAF GARLAND**

Ch 6. Sk 1st ch, sc (through 2 loops of the ch).

Ch 2. Sk 1st ch, sl st.

Working in same ch as 1st sc, dc and sl st.

Repeat!

*Materials:*

- Worsted weight yarn:
  - 15 yards Red Heart With Love in Holly Berry (red)
  - 5 yards Caron One Pound in Grass Green (green)
  - 2 yards Red Heart Super Saver in White (white)
- I hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- Red thread and sewing needle
- Pins

**STRAWBERRY POCKET**

With red worsted weight yarn, ch 7.

**Row 1:** Sk 1st 2 chs from hook, (2 hdc), 3 hdc, (2 hdc). – 7 sts

**Row 2:** Ch 2, turn. (2 hdc), 5 hdc, (2 hdc). – 9 sts

**Row 3:** Ch 2 turn. (2 hdc), 7 hdc, (2 hdc). – 11 sts

**Row 4:** Ch 2, turn. (2 hdc), 10 hdc. – 12 sts

**Row 5:** Ch 2, turn. (2 hdc), 11 hdc. – 13 sts

**Row 6:** Ch 2, turn. (2 hdc), 12 hdc. – 14 sts

**Row 7:** Ch 2, turn. (2 hdc), 13 hdc. – 15 sts

**Rows 8-9:** Ch 2, turn. Hdc evenly. – 15 sts

**Row 10:** Ch 2, turn. Sk 1, 12 hdc, sk 1, hdc. – 13 sts

**Row 11:** Ch 1, turn. Sk 1, 10 sc, sk 1, sc. – 11 sts

**Row 12:** Ch 1, turn, Sk 1, 8 sc, sk 1, sc. – 9 sts.

Break off and weave in both ends.

Block or flatten with your hands.

**LEAVES**

With green worsted weight yarn, ch 3 and sl st to 1st ch to form a ring.

Ch 5, sk 1st 2 chs from hook, 3 sc evenly, sl st into ring (stem complete). Ch 7, sk 1st ch from hook, 2 sl st, 4 sc, sl st into ring (Leaf 1 complete). [Ch 5, sk 1st ch from hook, 2 sl st, 2 sc, sl st into ring] 2 times (Leaf 2 & 3 complete). Ch 7, sk 1st ch from hook, 2 sl st, 4 sc, sl st into ring (Leaf 4 complete)

Break off leaving 24 inches of yarn for sewing later. Weave in other end and close up the ring.

**ASSEMBLY**

1. With white worsted weight yarn and yarn needle, make small stitches all over the strawberry to create seeds.

2. With yarn needle and long green yarn tail, sew Leaves to the top of the strawberry, making sure the stem is at the top and center, and that the 2 long leaves cover the top edge of the strawberry.

3. Pin the strawberry onto the sweater, bag or pants you are embellishing, and with red thread and sewing needle, sew the sides and bottom of the strawberry to complete the pocket.
