The finished pieces are lightweight and super easy to hang – perfect for sprucing up a bedroom or making any space your own.

### *You Will Learn:*

- Abstract painting techniques
- Tips for painting on fabric
- How to decide which parts of your painting to frame in embroidery hoops
- How to give your mounted fabric a clean finish
- How to hang your finished wall art

### *Tools and Materials:*

- 2 yards lightweight white cotton fabric
- Spray bottle
- Acrylic craft paints in a color way of your choice (Courtney uses teal blues, purples, red and pink)
- Jar of water
- Embroidery hoops in a variety of sizes (Courtney uses 4", 6", 8", and 10")
- Painting palette
- 2" - 3"-wide coarse-bristled paintbrushes
- Foam brush
- Utility knife
- Kraft paper or other scrap material to protect your work surface
