



## Modern Doily *with* Anna Maria Horner

Anna Maria puts her contemporary take on the traditional doily with this project. She shows you how to create a reversible doily with concentric rings of running stitches in a beautiful spectrum. The project is small enough that it's terrific for practicing and refining your hand sewing skills. And think again if you are put off my hand sewing – Anna shares tips and assurances along the way, as well as the satisfaction and pleasure she gets out of hand stitching a modern heirloom.



### *What You'll Learn*

- Running stitch
- Blind sewing
- Hiding knots at beginning and end of thread
- Bonus! Best hand sewing posture

### *Materials Needed*

- ½ yard cream colored linen fabric
- ½ yard mustard color cotton fabric
- Pearle Cotton thread in various colors
- Piece of scrap paper (8½ x 11 will do)
- T-Pin and tapestry needle
- Water soluble fabric pen
- Embroidery needle
- Iron and ironing board
- Sewing machine w/ matching thread
- Scissors
- Clear acrylic ruler
