

**Block of the Month: Polk Block***with* Carolyn Friedlander

Embrace the flexibility and spontaneity of paper piecing with this scrappy block. Carolyn Friedlander shows you how to select a color palette from your leftover bits of fabric and create a precise design using a template. Paper piecing with scraps enables you to use every last bit of fabric, so don't toss your scraps—save them for a project like this one.

*Learn How To:*

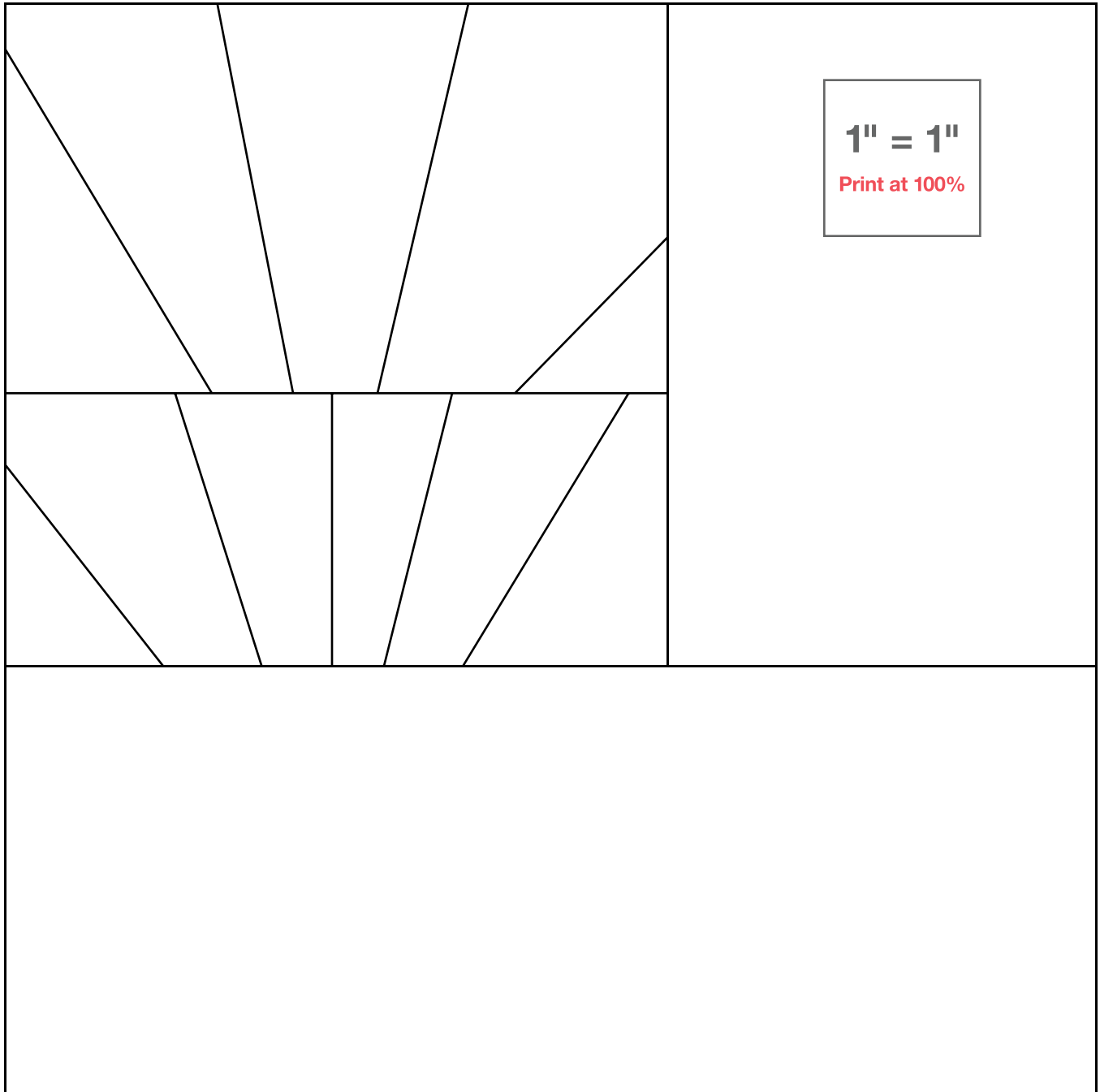
- Select scraps for your project
- Audition scraps on the template for fit and look
- Paper piece your block

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*Materials:*

- Sewing machine
- Table extension for sewing machine (optional)
- Sewing machine foot with good visibility of sewing area
- Matching cotton thread (50wt)
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter

- Sharp snips
- Iron/ironing surface
- Marking utensil (optional)
- Scraps of desired fabrics (some scraps should be 3 1/2" wide for larger portions of block)
- Quilting pins
- PDF Template
